COVID-19 INFORMATION

HOW LONG TO STAY HOME FROM SCHOOL

The amount of time a student needs to stay home from school depends on the type of symptoms. For more details: Isolation requirements

If a student has What to do these symptoms Fever · Isolate at home for a minimum of 10 days from when symptoms started or until symptoms resolve, whichever is longer. Cough COVID-19 testing is recommended. Shortness of breath or . Can return to school before 10 days only if a COVID-19 test is negative, difficulty breathing symptoms are gone, and the student was not a close contact of Loss of sense of smell or taste someone with COVID-19. · Do not enter any long-term care settings for 10 days and until symptoms . If test results are positive, isolate at home for at least 10 days and follow instructions received from Alberta Health Services. . Stay home from school and monitor for 24 hours. If after 24 hours your One of the following symptoms: symptoms improve, you may return to school when you are feeling better. Chills A COVID-19 test is not required but is available. Sore throat/painful swallowing · Do not enter any long-term care settings for 10 days and until symptoms Runny nose/congestion have resolved. Headache If a child has any two of these symptoms, or after 24 hours, their condition Muscle or joint aches gets worse or they develop a second symptom: Feeling unwell/fatigued COVID-19 test recommended. Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea May return to school after symptoms are gone, even without a COVID-19 Unexplained loss of appetite Muscle/joint aches · Do not enter any long-term care settings for 10 days and until symptoms Headache have resolved. Pink eye (conjunctivitis) · If test results are positive, isolate at home for at least 10 days and follow instructions received from Alberta Health Services.

SWANAVON Parent Guide: Learning while in Quarantine

This year all PK-6 students at SWANAVON have Google accounts, with access to Google Classrooms or Google Sites that can be used and accessed while at school and while at home. Parents it is IMPERATIVE that you have your child setup on Google Classroom at home. Your child's teacher would have shared your child's username and password in an email with you. We are asking that you have your child setup by October 16. Please reach out to your child's teachers if you are experiencing difficulty logging on. They are here to help and support you through this process.

What is a Google Site?

Google Sites are websites teachers can modify to create a unique classroom website.

What is Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is an online classroom. It makes it easy to create classes, distribute assignments, communicate, and stay organized. Google Classroom increases the ease at which students can hand in assignments from home.

What is Google Meet?

Google Meet is a conference software like Zoom that teachers can use to teach live, interactive lessons online.
