Principal Report: Garth Paquette

This past month a Native Storyteller came in to talk and the kids really enjoyed listening to the stories and getting involved. The Alberta Assurance Education Survey has also been sent out to parents of grade 4 and 6 students. Parent Council is asked to please share the post on Facebook reminding parents who received the email to follow the link and complete the survey. This survey is very important as it helps evaluate the education of our students in the school and across the province. Another email will be sent out later in the year for the School Division Survey to the parents of grade 4-6 students and staff. Parent Council is asked to please share that Facebook post as well. The new school website has also launched. It is very user friendly and keeps in mind that most users will be on their phone to view the website. There is also a new calendar that you can subscribe too! You can subscribe with the option to just add it as it is in its current state or a dynamic (live) option that will update as things are added or changed. Things coming up to keep an eye on include the Winter Walk on February 7th, the 100th Day of School on February 14th, & Pink Shirt Day (Anti-Bullying) is February 29th. She also did a Demo of the Literacy Education Tools that were purchased with funds donated from Parent Council last year (\$1500 was donated last year from the parent council and the Literacy, Tech, and Science fund)
